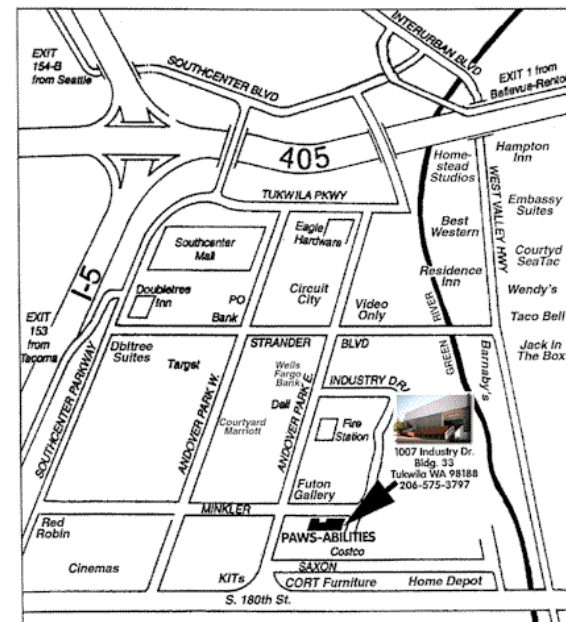

- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" that accompanies the Official AKC entry form.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Changes received by telephone are not accepted.
- Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.
- Entries received without fees will not be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Entries accompanied by returned checks will be charged an additional \$20 fee.
- There is no refund for duplicate entries or overpayments. The Match Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Match Committee. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the match cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time for judging. After being judged, dogs not required for further judging may be excused.
- Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Exhibitors are responsible to pick up after their dog – no exceptions!
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Match Committee, be asked to leave the match site. In such case, no refund of any entry fee shall be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring.
- Dogs are allowed in rings during judging only.
- There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the match grounds.
- Bulldog Club of Greater Seattle, its officers and members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property or children.
- Professional Handlers are permitted to exhibit any dog at this match.
- Prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog. No awards will be mailed.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
